1. Weekly Training Fees

Artistry AGG uses Revolutionize Sport Platform to enrol in all training sessions. Training fees are calculated by the hours of training of each individual gymnast each weekday and their agreed attendance hours. The entire term must be paid for in advance. All fees must be paid 7 days following receiving the invoice from the Club and also in advance of any holiday training. New gymnasts starting part way through the term are charged on a pro rata basis. There are 40 Weeks of training throughout 2022. Each term has a different number of weeks and will be invoiced accordingly. The Term Dates are on the website: www.artistryagg.com

The fees above do not include yearly AAGGF registration, Artistry AGG Yearly/Joining Fee nor additional training sessions or workshops, which will be billed separately. See below for more information.

Artistry AGG reserves the right to increase or decrease fees based on Covid 19 Restrictions and other influencing factors. Please see below further information on "makeup sessions".



2. Australian Aesthetic Group Gymnastics Federation - Registration Fee for All AGG Gymnasts

Artistry AGG is registered and affiliated with the Australian Aesthetic Group Gymnastics Federation (AAGGF) which is further governed by the International Federation of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics (IFAGG). All gymnasts, coaches and judges must be registered members of the above-mentioned organisation. An annual registration fee that provides is required for all Artistry AGG members participating in AGG Gymnastics. This registration fee is set by AAGGF every year and is paid on behalf of the gymnast when required by AAGGF. It is a non-refundable fee, however, it is transferrable if the gymnast moves to another AGG Club.

NB: At this stage, the AAGGF has not yet set the 2021 registration fee but as a guide, the fee was \$75 in 2020. Artistry AGG will not collect the fee until asked to do so by the AAGGF.

3. Joining/Yearly Admin Fee- \$50

An annual Club membership fee of **\$50** is payable upon joining Artistry AGG Gymnastics Club and yearly thereafter. This fee contributes to the administration costs to operate the Gymnastics program as well as all administration expenses, First-Aid supplies including ice-packs, Band-Aids, tissues, etc. It also contributes to the overall Public Liability Insurance Cover.

All gymnasts are required to contribute to the maintenance of the equipment and Club. This cost contributes to the items required to maintain and upgrade the equipment in the Gymnastics Club as well as, abiding by Covid 19 cleanliness, sanitation and government guidelines. Covid 19 has greatly increased the need to clean and sanitise program stations and equipment. The levy is now included in your Yearly/Joining Fee and in training fees.

4. Competition Fee

Gymnasts who are invited to participate in competitions are required to pay a competition fee when they participate in a competition. This is to cover the costs of their entry fee (which is passed on to the organising Club) and accompanying coaches time.

Gymnasts will be invited to compete in certain events as per the competition calendar. TBC.

You will be required to pay the fees approximatively 6 weeks prior to the event. The office administration will send you a link for booking and payment. Entry into competitions is strictly by invitation only and we encourage all to strive towards inclusion in these exciting events.



Should a gymnast be sick or injured and unable to compete they may be entitled to a refund at the discretion of the Coach and the hosting Club.

Please note that to represent the club at any competitions, club training fees must be completely up to date.

5. Travel Levy

Some competitive gymnasts will be invited to compete interstate and overseas.

A Travel Levy will apply to cover all staff/coach travel costs associated with these competitions. This amount is divided by the number of gymnasts on the competing team. Travelling for competitions is not compulsory however if a gymnast is chosen and agrees to compete nationally or internationally, the commitment is by way of a firm agreement and once agreed gymnast cannot withdraw. Strict rules apply to inclusion in these prestigious events and all rules must be adhered to whilst representing Artistry AGG. These rules will be advised closer to the competitions.

6. Uniform Fees - Training & Competition

The "all black" Training Uniform is to be provided by the gymnast.

Some Artistry AGG merchandise items can be purchased from the Club, like T-Shirts etc.

It is compulsory for all competing gymnasts to buy and wear the agreed competition leotard. The coach will advise the cost at the time. Payment must be made prior to collection. These leotards/competition wear are precious and beautiful and need to be kept in plastic suit bags for protection. The gymnast will need to supply their own makeup and hair products (unless you would like to pay the Makeup Levy – See Below).

Gymnasts competing in competition teams will be provided with a Club tracksuit top for competition. These Club Jackets remain the property of Artistry AGG and must be returned in good condition. Should a gymnast lose or damage the jacket, then full replacement cost will be required to be paid to the Club.

7. Extra Training Fees & Specialist Workshops

Gymnasts may be offered extra training sessions before a competition in addition to their regular training times. Extra hours will be charged separately from a gymnast's normal session rate. These



training sessions can land on public holidays and Sundays and competing gymnasts should make themselves available and attend. Failure to do so may deem the gymnast not ready to compete and may be asked to “wait out” the competition. Extra training is charged at the gymnasts normal weekly training rate.

Specialist training opportunities and workshops are offered from time to time and are charged in accordance with the particular Coach, activity or workshop genre.

8. School Holiday Training

Holiday training is offered and highly encouraged for all gymnasts and the general community. The fee for the holiday training will be billed through a “trybooking” link sent out before the holidays commence. Holiday training fees are separate to normal training fees.

9. Public Holidays

For most groups, there is no training on Victorian and Australian Public Holidays.

At times competing gymnasts may be asked to train leading up to a competition. Fees will be billed separately. At the Clubs discretion gymnasts may be called to training at a unique workshop or event opportunity.

10. Christmas Show Fees

Should Artistry AGG run a Christmas show or Display Day at the end of year, a costume fee will be charged depending on the costume chosen and the age of the gymnast. This can range from \$20 - \$200 depending on the age and level of the gymnast. Costumes can be used in future competitions and events. This will be invoiced either in the last term invoice or separately. There will also be an \$80 fee for the actual display day that covers rehearsals, set up, pack down, additional staff, some music editing, lighting and awards etc.



11. Dance Training

Ballet & Jazz training may be offered for some groups as well as, specialist workshops. You will be advised about fees and options. These will be invoiced separately or a link will be sent out through “trybooking”.

12. Private Lessons

One-on-one private lessons (in person or online) cost is as follows:

Private Lesson \$80 per hour \$50 per half an hour

It is possible to have a semi-private lesson, when there is a maximum of 2 girls sharing the time and cost for a minimum of one hour.

Private lesson will progress a gymnast faster and focus on flexibility, strength, skills, choreography and helps with retention of routines. They are also used for developing solos if required.

13. Other Miscellaneous Expenses

- Music Editing \$25 per gymnast if required for a solo (not applicable for AGG group routines)
- Makeup Levy (should you be unable to accurately apply the correct makeup for competitions your Coach will assist) \$25 per gymnast
- Stretch Bands & Weights, Rhythmic Gymnastics Ropes & Balls (Buy from Amco, Bloch, Decathlon or Rebel Sports) as requested by the Coach. Some may be stocked at the gym at times.

14. Payment of fees

Invoices will be provided. Full payment of all gymnastics fees must be made by the due date on the invoice. Payments are due 7 days from the date of the invoice. Instalment Plans are available – contact Admin. Instalments may be made in no more than 3 equal payments over a Term.

15. Late Payment Fee

Overdue fee payments will incur a \$50 administration charge after 7 days



16. Outstanding Fees

If fees are 2 weeks overdue, gymnasts will no longer be allowed to train until fees have been paid in full or an instalment plan is activated. Severely outstanding fees will be referred to a debt collector and incur further costs.

17. Payment Methods

Weekly Training Fees should be paid by Direct Debit into the Artistry AGG Account.

Holiday programs and workshops payments should be by Credit Card through Trybooking at the time.

18. Difficulty With Payment

Please contact the Club Director for a confidential discussion to resolve and make a payment plan. The signatory on the Enrolment form is responsible for the settlement of all accounts.

19. Gymnasts Extended Absences

Gymnasts who have extended absences (holiday or any other reason) are not entitled to a fee reduction unless pre-approved by the Club Director.

Injury and illness with a doctor's certificate provided will allow for a 50% credit applied for use on future term fees.

No refund or discount on fees is given for gymnasts away on gymnastics competition trips with the Club, as Coaching continues throughout the travel period. (Recreational classes continue on allocated days even when competing gymnasts are away)

20. Injury or Illness

Gymnasts who miss a training session due to sickness or injury are not entitled to a fee reduction.

Gymnasts may be eligible for a credit of 50% of fees in the case of injury or illness. The absence must be for a period of three or more consecutive weeks.

A medical certificate covering the whole period must be provided.



If the gymnast is training a modified program, she is not eligible for this credit.

21. Withdrawal from the Program

If a gymnast wishes to withdraw from the Program, they must provide at least 4 weeks' written notification to the Club prior to leaving. If committed to compete, the gymnast cannot leave until after the competition commitment has occurred.

22. Make-up classes

If you have to miss a training session for important occasions (such as wedding) or for injury/medical reasons, you may attend on an alternative offered weekday. Please advise at the time. Every term, "Make-up" classes are offered on a Sunday later in the term for gymnasts to "catch up" on missed training. If the class has been cancelled by the Church Hall, club or coach, then a "makeup" session will be offered on a special Sunday session later in the term. Any class cancelled by the Club or coach will need to be made up by the end of the term by agreement with the coach. No refund is given for a missed class unless a Doctors certificate stating serious illness or injury is sighted by the Head Coach at which 50% may be credited to your account for the time off due to illness/injury. It is expected parents make the gymnast available for makeup training. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure the hours trained equate to the hour's invoices and subsequently paid in each term. "makeup" training is never rolled over into the following term. It must be attended within the term. Hours reset at the commencement of each term. Please note kids birthday parties, tardiness, family functions, other frivolous commitments are not applicable too makeup training. All "makeup " training needs to be requested and approved by the head coach.

23. Discount and Special Offers

- Sibling discount of 5% is allocated to a second siblings who attends Artistry AGG. If you receive the sibling discount, you do not qualify for any other special offers or discounts. However, the original child, can receive special offers i.e. "Early Bird Rate" however all siblings accounts need to be settled by the early bird date as specified. Early Bird and sibling discounts are not offered during and post Covid 19 lockdowns as determined by the Head Coach.



- Early Bird Special is offered at the discrepancy of the club. The term fees must be paid prior to the date specified to receive the discount. The full terms fees will be applicable after this date.

24. Heat Policy

Should the temperature reach 36 degrees Celsius, as reported at 1pm on the Bureau of Meteorology website for the Melbourne Metropolitan area, any afternoon training will be cancelled for health & safety reasons.

A notification about cancelled training will be posted on the Facebook page of the club and in the private group. (Please ensure you request to become a member of the Facebook group – See Below) Any classes cancelled for this reason can be replaced with another class before the end of that term. No refund will be provided for missed class due to high temperature.

25. Covid 19 Online Training Fees & Makeup Lessons & Extended Lockdown Policy

Due to the ongoing Global Pandemic, Artistry AGG implemented a Covid 19 lockdown policy.

Gymnasts enrol in our program for the entire term or pro rata from commencement to term end. If and when a lockdown occurs in Melbourne due to Covid 19 the following applies:

- Covid 19 lockdowns **do not** entitle gymnasts to a fee reduction, credit or refund. However, “makeup” training is permitted within the term and/or **upon special request**, during that terms holiday training programs.
- Other options may be offered on case by case basis, during “Extended Lockdown Periods” of more than 4 Weeks... but only for gymnasts under 7 years old. Gymnasts 7 years + can use “makeup” hours owed for holiday programs, weekly training, workshops/one-off events and upon request, for private lessons. During “Extended Lockdowns”, “makeup” hours may be rolled-over into the next term at the discretion of the Head Coach.
- Classes will immediately commence online via Zoom. Training hours online will be a reduced timetable which will be sent to families prior to the first online training. It is expected



gymnasts adapt to Zoom training and Artistry AGG endeavours to keep these online training sessions fun and safe, adding games, workshops and challenges to keep things interesting and stimulating.

- It is imperative that parents encourage their young gymnasts during these online sessions and insure their space is clear, safe and adequate for the child to train.
- Only gymnasts under 4 years old can apply for special consideration for these Zoom training sessions. This must be done in writing via email. We will work together to “makeup” these special consideration hours throughout the term post lockdown.
- Fees for online Zoom training remain the same as the Weekly term fees as invoiced.
- Artistry offers a special Sunday training session every term for gymnasts to “makeup” missed training hours, as well as, offers gymnasts to attend another or additional weekly training on another week day.
- Artistry Administration maintains a strict roll of attendance both online and in the gym. Our spreadsheet calculates all hours the gymnast has attended training (in person and online) and shows the outstanding hours not equal to the invoiced hours. You will be advised via email of the relevant and “allowable” makeup hours and any suggested dates for additional “makeup” attendance.

Example (1):

Shelley was planning to train 30 Hours in the term. Her mother was invoiced and paid for 30 hours of training. Due to a snap Covid Lockdown for two weeks her training hours were reduced. As she approached the end of term, she had 5 outstanding training hours which she chose to “makeup” by adding 2 hours on another weekday and 3 hours was made-up at the Special Sunday “makeup” training as offered every term. Her hours of training then equalled her hours as invoiced.

Example (2):

Lisa was planning to train 15 Hours in the term. Her mother was invoiced and paid for 15 hours of training. Due to a snap Covid Lockdown for one week her training hours were reduced. As she approached the end of term, she had 1 outstanding training hour which she chose to “makeup” by joining an alternative day. Her hours of training then equalled her hours as invoiced.
